DUTY

To act consistently with and seek to further the objects of the Pastoral Land Act 1992. including to provide for the:

- sustainable use of land for pastoral purposes and the economic viability of the pastoral industry
- monitoring of pastoral land so as to detect and assess any change in its condition
- prevention or minimisation of degradation of or other damage to the land and its indigenous plant and animal life
- rehabilitation of the land in cases of degradation or other damage
